Dear Parents:

We are continuing our “color code” system for all subjects. This will help students to become more organized as each subject is a different color. We hope to eliminate much of the time wasted looking for different subject notebooks, folders, etc. in desks and lockers. The “color code” system will be uniform throughout the school in Grades 2-8 so students will become very familiar with each subject being a certain color. The colors will be as follows:

Religion – Yellow	Social Studies - Purple
Reading – Red	English - Blue
Math – Black	Science – Green
Spanish – Optional (Your choice of folder) (only 6-8)	

To assist you in your summer shopping, the teachers have provided a list of the items they require in their classroom. A reading list is also included for those rainy days by grade level. In addition to this list of school supplies, each child should bring to school:

A box of tissues
A package of paper plates
A package of luncheon-size napkins
1 Roll of paper towels
