Purpose...

Mak.er.space. (noun) - a place in which people with shared interests, especially in computing or technology, can gather to work on projects while sharing ideas, equipment, and knowledge.

In 2019, we celebrate 125 years of high-quality and affordable Catholic faith-based education at SJS. We do so while ensuring every child has access to a quality education and providing financial aid to 17 percent of our student body; a student base comprised of 19 communities across the North Shore and Greater Boston areas. Today, we must ensure we are meeting the learning and educational needs of our students and that, of course, includes a focus on science, technology, engineering, art and mathematics (STEAM).

Lori Gracey, Executive Director of the Texas Computer Education Center (TCEA) states; "Makerspaces provide a place for students to explore questions, bounce ideas off one another, build something together, fail and try again all in a safe creative environment." For that reason, the board, administration and faculty aim to deliver a Makerspace in the School Library at SJS. The School Library Makerspace is an innovative way to support 21st century learning by promoting a collaborative culture of thinking, exploring, inventing and building. The library space will be reimaged to become a true hub for inquiry and learning with the assistance of educational resources and tools that go beyond books and technology.

Our Goal...

The Library Makerspace is a **\$50,000 project**; of which we have **\$25,000 committed**; pending **we raise another \$25,000**. The 125th celebration and awards dinner on October 18, 2019, will allow us to secure the remaining funds needed to procure the following:

- ◆ New moveable furniture and storage
- ◆ LEGO Wall
- ◆ (2) 3D printers
- ◆ Filament for Printing
- ◆ 25 Chromebooks and/or iPad(s)
- ◆ Training programs for all teachers, administrators and support staff
- ◆ Part-time staffing for a Makerspace Coordinator
- ◆ STEAM kits available for purchase that are designed by age, grade, and ability levels
